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letter from

Agustín Alonso SJ Entreculturas Director

Dear Friends of Entreculturas:

Since last year's letter, many people have come our way, both in Latin America and Africa. My most vivid image is of the boys and girls, 11.000 in total, at the Refugee Camps in Rwanda, where the education given by the Jesuit Refugee Service will be the only belonging they will be able to take back with them when they return to their home countries. There is a face, a story, behind each person. Hundreds of faces who are friends, new opportunities to meet, to accompany and to work with, side by side, in a world in permanent evolution; sometimes with the joy of achieving hopeful changes and sometimes, simply accompanying the pain and trying to make it hurt less.

"People in movement" has been the motto of our National Encounter, mainly focused on the African continent. Movement and Africa, an attitude and a reality that have marked our activity during this past year.

Movement and opening to Africa. We have worked, together with Fe y Alegría, on how to support education in the African continent, especially with the Jesuit Refugee Service. To accompany, serve and defend those who accompany, serve and defend is the task of Entreculturas and our way of being present in Africa.

The Fe y Alegría schools advance in their opening to society. This was agreed at the 37th International Congress of this Movement in Bolivia under the title "Education and Community Social Promotion". This line of work is recommended by us in our report "The Official Aid for Education in Spotlight" a first analysis of the Spanish official cooperation on education in the framework of our advocacy work in the North.

Many friends from Latin America have visited us this year, sharing their concerns and projects and our work and worries with us. Many of them have also come from Africa, increasingly present in Entreculturas.

Last of all, our permanent internal thinking and discussion to increase and improve our work. Improvement regarding the management of our projects, the education given in the schools we support and our internal work, keeping a permanent attitude of transparency and open to what our collaborators have to say to us. All of this will make up our future Strategic Plan 2008-2012.

We try to walk this path with our local partners and the populations we support, side by side, feeling their setbacks and joys. Because, in the end, this is the only way that the building of a local and global fairer world will be able to answer to the different cultures, concerns and realities that live together on earth.

What do we do in the South?

We aim for education to reach the largest number of people but always improving its quality and aimed at social change. For this purpose, we support initiatives that promote the education for the less favoured in Latin America, Africa and Asia. We not only carry out specific projects but we also accompany educational programmes and procedures. Education and community promotion are complementary in advancing towards civic, labour and social participation and democratic behaviour. Building classrooms, educating teachers, supporting radio based education programmes, labour skill training centres or promoting education in refugee camps are among the activities we carry out.

What do we do in Spain?

A change of conscience in the North is the key to end the unfair international relations. We carry out campaigns on education, communication and research to make the Spanish society aware that education is essential for development. We also work on public advocacy in order to make governments meet their international commitments for a world with more justice. In 2004, we were named representatives of the Development NGOs in the Development Council together with four other organisations. Our work in Spain is possible thanks to the efforts and enthusiasm of hundreds of volunteers who make this objective a worthy cause of self engagement.

Why is the lack of education a priority problem?

Since 2000, 30 million more children go to school. But progress is too slow. At this rhythm, many countries will not succeed in having an Education for All until 2150, leaving way behind the engagement of attaining the goal by 2015. This limitation will determine their lives. We believe education is a key tool in order to reduce the vulnerable position of millions of people in the world. The education we believe in enables job opportunities, self esteem and social awareness for change.





Our Partners in the South

Our main partners in America and Africa are the popular education movement Fe y Alegría and the Jesuit Refugee Service (JRS). The quality and seriousness of their work has been proved for decades. Entreculturas is one of the members of the Fe y Alegría network, one of the most relevant worldwide educational organizations in 17 countries with 1.200.000 students. The JRS promotes education in the very difficult environment of the refugee camps and displaced populations as a consequence of the many armed conflicts, unstable political situations and natural catastrophes that take place nowadays.

Do we have network initiatives?

We are firm believers in networking with other social agents as enrichment both in thinking processes and in the impact of projects and promoted activities. We work in close collaboration with Alboan and other Spanish Development NGOs. We belong to the Xavier Network (European NGOs network closely related to the Society of Jesus). We support joint Campaigns with the Spanish Development NGO Coordinator, CONGDE, regional and local coordinators and with the REDES Platform which we currently preside. We are members of the Global Campaign for Education, the Spanish Coalition to Stop the Use of Child Soldiers and the "No doubt, no debt" campaign.

How do we control the actual distribution of our funds?

All our accounts are audited by an external audit firm on an annual basis which is included in this report. The audit for the year 2006 has been done by BDO Audiberia. In order to ensure our good practices, we submit to the evaluation of the Follow Up Commission of the Code of Conduct of the CONGDE, of which our Deputy Director is a member and Fundación Lealtad analyzes our degree of transparency. This Foundation's report, for 2006, has established once again that we comply with all the required maximums. Finally, all donor institutions control the final destination of their contributions and make their own evaluation of our joint projects.

Our accounts

In Entreculturas we are making a major effort in order to increase donations from members or donors who wish to share our project. During the year 2006, 53% of our funds have been raised by our contributors and there are increasingly more people who support our work in a continuous way, convinced that the real commitment for development cannot be the result of responding by impulses to concrete actions. The other donations received come from public entities such as the Spanish Agency for International Cooperation (AECI) through Programmes and Agreements for Latin America and other institutions such as the municipalities and regional governments. 92,8% of total funds received has been used in projects in the South and for development aid education and social awareness education in the North.

How can you help?

We suggest you join as a member, giving a donation, enrolling in our volunteer programmes or participating in the campaigns we promote either individually or collectively. Another very useful way of collaborating is to be well informed on our reality, the causes of unequal situations and injustice and communicating that access to education abolishes unequal situations and transforms vulnerable realities.

It works to educate in all dimensions promoting a free and responsible individual; an education striving for change from and with the communities to build a fairer, fraternal, democratic and participating society. Today, the schools of Fe y Alegría are in popular areas of 16 countries with more than one million two thousand pupils. Entreculturas is part of the Federation since its foundation, as a full member.

The **Jesuit Refugee Service (JRS)** accompanies serves and defends the refugee's and displaced person's rights, worldwide for the past 25 years. To accomplish this, it carries out child and adult education programmes, social services and counselling, pastoral and medical care. The JRS mission is directed to all those people who have been forced to abandon their homes because of conflicts, human disasters or the violation of human rights. 



Our cooperation for development work aims to support the development of the more vulnerable populations through **popular education as a fundamental pillar,** trying to impact on the community problems.

Entreculturas tries to place the human being at the centre of its activities. We recognize that the individual is only fully developed in its community; therefore, our work is oriented to promoting honest **people committed to their environment.** This option for the human being is accompanied by community and network building, with spaces for sharing and supporting one another.

Entreculturas understands that Cooperation for Development has to be based on dialogue and joint work between all implicated actors. **Stable alliances** between North and South organizations, added to **the beneficiaries voices** with full knowledge and contact with reality, are essential in order to advance towards a fairer world in the framework of mutual collaboration. The ignorance or bad interpretation of determined cultural contexts can make development processes difficult.

We firmly believe that our work **should be focused on the causes.** It should promote international advocacy and public action. We should work from the view of the excluded, trying to develop their potential as capable and critical citizens.

Support of the Popular Education in Latin America, hand in hand with Fe y Alegría

Latin America continues to be the world's most unequal region. The economic, social and cultural breach has a clear source in ethnics, gender or residence. This breach which affects societies in the entire region affects daily life and the capacity of sharing a common future. In the education world, the main differences are seen in the quality of education. The social polarization in the access to a quality education is a clear proof of the existing inequalities.

Fe y Alegría assumes education as a pedagogical and political proposal for transformation. As a "Movement of Popular Education and Social Promotion", it promotes an education targeted to the impoverished and excluded sectors in order to promote their personal development and social participation. Entreculturas is a supporting platform for Fe y Alegría, our main partner in Latin America and with whom we share work and mission.





In a continent where education needs to be included in the political agenda and civil society needs to be articulated through solid organizations, Fe y Alegría has the challenge to become a subject of public activity capable of impacting in policies and programmes to promote quality education for all; to overcome poverty and end social exclusion; to develop institutional strength and promote management so as to reinforce its identity and guarantee the economic and social sustainability of the Movement.

Accompanying the world's refugees, hand in hand with the JRS

In an increasingly global world, Africa is searching for her own identity. This makes us recognize her capacities and limitations. Africa is a complex continent, plural and creative, well beyond stereotypes.

In this context, Entreculturas gives priority support to the Jesuit Refugee Service which firmly believes the African Jesuits' responsibility in the task of building a new Africa.







The work of the JRS in defence of the rights of the displaced and refugees in the continent and its firm commitment to their education, currently faces a changing reality. The traditional African values, such as hospitality seem to diminish. The refugees are no longer guests, they have become strangers. The current model of the refugee camp is not working. Alternatives are necessary in order to improve the situation of the refugees, enabling their insertion in the receiving community and promoting their independence.


All this work is carried out in a continent whose main challenges are to address the worrying impact of HIV/ AIDS, to overcome existing armed conflicts, to develop better run governments with greater attention to social concerns, making the local community beneficiary of the exploitation of natural resources, in addition to contributing to sustainable development.

Thus the importance the JRS gives to civil society as a watchdog of these processes and its need to continue advocacy promotion.

What we do



We work in Latin America, Africa and Asia together with other organisations with strong local ties. We jointly plan and carry out proposals for life quality improvement and development opportunities for the most needed.

In order to achieve this, we carry out **action plans** to structure, develop and define by geographical areas, the sector priorities of our cooperation in the South. These plans are structured at regional and country level.

The action plans are carried out by programmes, projects and specific activities. The **programmes** are only carried out with our strategic partners at international level on a long term basis. These programmes have other implications with Entreculturas' objectives, such as advocacy, education for development or volunteer activities. The **projects** address concrete objectives and results to solve significant problems of beneficiaries in a determined period of time. The **activities** are **punctual**, with time and content limit.

In order to carry all this out, Entreculturas provides human, technical and financial support.



Engagement with Quality Education


Education, in order to be a truly effective tool for change, must be a Quality Education. Strong public education systems, a participating school community, sufficient teacher and education personnel, dynamic curricula, new technologies and education evaluation systems are some of the elements needed for the quality we intend to achieve.

Under the agreement that Entreculturas has signed with the Spanish Agency for International Cooperation, directed to the most vulnerable and deprived children, we try to improve primary education in Latin America. The programme aims to impact on both universal access and improving the education quality. To impact on the latter, the agreement addresses management and teacher training and community participation. The local Fe y Alegrías will be responsible for carrying out the programme.

The programme will be carried out during the next four years in priority countries that require special attention from the Spanish Cooperation: Bolivia, Ecuador, Colombia, Peru, Paraguay, Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, Nicaragua, Costa Rica, Panama and Dominican Republic, in addition to Argentina and Haiti where it is hoped to be reproduced and will impact the education sector.

Living in peace

Dominican Republic and Haiti are two countries in permanent tension motivated by the movement of Haitians to the neighbouring country. Solidaridad Fronteriza, the name given to the Jesuit Refugee and Migrant Service, together with its counterpart Solidarité Frontière in Haiti, work to achieve peaceful living and social justice, supported by Entreculturas.

Through workshops, these organizations try to help the Dominican population to see the immigration as an opportunity and the Haitian population, at both sides of the border, to improve its self esteem and be aware of its rights. Solidaridad Fronteriza also works so that the Administration, the Army and other professionals with social influence, such as journalists or lawyers, change their attitudes towards immigrants.

Convinced of the implied strength of working together, Solidaridad Fronteriza tries to articulate and strengthen local associations so that their voice may be taken into account in municipal matters. This objective is in the framework of the hard and constant advocacy work that the Jesuit Refugee and Migrant Service carry out in Dominican Republic.

Radio based education for adults

Bolivia is not only one of Latin America's three poorest countries; it has also the highest inequality rates. The lack of access to education is key in enlarging and mantaining the social breach. To the low education coverage, we have to add the poor objectives, methodologies and curricula where the student memorizes and repeats with no analysis or context. Teaching is tedious and there is also a lack of government teachers and personnel for adult education and people have little opportunities to develop and improve citizen participation.

In this context, 33.600 youth and adults try to work for their own future. Through the radio programme "Teacher at Home" run by the Instituto Radiofónico Fe y Alegría (IRFA) they try to follow education programmes that were denied to them as children for reasons such as their cultural origin, living in rural areas or the fact of being a woman in a context where this can determine school attendance. This programme offers alternative distance edu-

cation for 33.600 adults and youth; all of them illiterate or forced to abandon school early. Radio is a literacy and primary education tool with transversal impact in matters such as development, democracy and citizenship. The homes and work sites change, for a time, into education spaces, making education relate directly to the citizen's daily life.

Uvira Child Soldiers

"We were five friends, but one of us died in a combat". These words are especially hard when said by a 17 year old Congolese boy. A boy whose dream, at this mo-



ment, is to work for his community in his own mechanic garage. And this will be possible thanks to the work that the Jesuit Refugee Service carries out at the Uvira Transit and Orientation Centre with the support of Entreculturas.

Once the JRS finds these children and manages to demobilize them, it transfers them to the Centre. The challenge is to enable them to lead a normal life, since the children have deep psychological traumas. Education plays an important role so they are offered the possibility of literacy; to continue with their studies or professional training. Hairdressing, carpentry, soap manufacturing or mechanics are some of the education alternatives offered at the Centre.

When the stay at the Centre is ended and after a raising awareness process in families and community, the time for reinsertion comes. The child returns home or to the home of a relative where he will continue studying or start a small activity with the help of a "kit" provided by the JRS.

Hope for the future after the tsunami

During 2006, together with a Television team, we visited the Aceh Province, in the island of Sumatra, the worst hit by the tsunami in December 2004, and we witnessed the reconstruction work that the Jesuit Refugee Service (JRS) carries out with our support.

We talked with brave women, capable of overcoming the adversity that took away their husbands, children and possessions. Women like those in Lamno who not only weave straw mats but also the beginning of a new life. Entreculturas supports these income generating activities by granting loans without interests. The criteria when supporting an activity is that the beneficiary must be extremely vulnerable and the activity will benefit the community. This is the case of steelwork shops, motor bike repairs or the fishing tools for a community, where aid aims to be coherent with a sustainable development that will not generate future dependencies.

We visited schools full of students in newly built buildings or in tents in the sand. We met volunteer teachers supported by the JRS and convinced of the importance of education. And we have accompanied JRS volunteers in the extra curricular activities they carry out, not only to help

with school work, but to help them overcome the traumas inflicted by the tsunami and by the armed conflict the region has been immersed in over the past 30 years and which ended in August with the signing of a peace agreement by the government and the GAM guerrilla group.

The accompaniment of the JRS is a cooperation in which the beneficiaries are truly responsible for their own development.

Luisa Pernalete, Director of the Fe y Alegría schools in Guayana, Venezuela and a pro human rights activist, came to Spain with Entreculturas to tell us about the lessons she learnt during her years of experience with the most vulnerable communities. From her back pack, or "corralito" she unfolded all sorts of pieces that build a whole theory of popular education, an education for people committed to their context and eager for change. All of this wrapped up with humour and creativity.

In the towns she visited, she showed her hat full of flowers, because a popular teacher not only has to evaluate pupil's progress, but also show it by "giving flowers". She also showed her panoramic glasses, because the work with the students has to be done taking the context into account; her introspective glasses to look at the heart, her wig for creative ideas, since each situation requires a different answer. Her bag also carries a "zampoña", an instrument made up of different size tubes which reminds us that each one of the students has a unique value for the group, or a little trumpet which alerts us on listening to what is not said.



Entreculturas publishes "The Official Development Aid for Education in Spotlight" first report on the strategy of the Spanish Cooperation for Education.

"The Official Aid for Development in Spotlight. Analysis of the Spanish cooperation: 1999-2004" report was published at a decisive moment and contributed with specific suggestions to the elaboration of the Spanish Cooperation for Education Strategy with an impact on the Official Aid for Development policy.

With this document, Entreculturas and Alboan have demanded the Spanish government to:

-- Increase **funds for basic education** through greater and better Aid for Development. Entreculturas considers as basic education: infant, primary and secondary school and adult literacy.

- -- Re-direct aid to the less favoured countries or populations.
- -- Better and more coordinated work by all agents involved.

--- Improve aid quality, taking into account the needs of the receiving countries, making the necessary changes, when needed, in specific areas of **collaboration and promoting coordination** and complementary aspects between different agents. -- **Demand that aid should not be tied to the commercial interests of Spanish business firms.**



Advocacy in Latin America

The Fe y Alegría Federation has a Public Action Programme, led by Entreculturas, to promote awareness at continental level on the importance of quality education as a public good and to promote social agreements. Although according to Luis Arancibia, Entreculturas Deputy Director, "the goal of this programme is to promote dialogue to generate agreements".

With the campaigns, we aim to mobilize citizens to speak out and demand the politicians to engage in solving unfair situations that prevent people's development. We work with organizations such as Intermón Oxfam, Educación sin Fronteras, Save the Children, Alboan, Amnesty International, Fundación el Compromiso, Action Aid, REDES, trade unions... Entreculturas considers that working together provides richness and opportunity.

* Global Campaign for Education (GCE) aims to meet the international community's engagements at the 2000 Dakar Summit, with special relevance to the goal regarding that before 2015 all children may receive a quality primary education. This campaign is active in more than 115 countries. The Spanish Coalition is made up of Action Aid, Intermón Oxfam and Entreculturas. • 2006 Global Education Campaign Action Week. More than 40.000 boys and girls and around 400 schools were mobilized in Spain under the motto "Every child needs a teacher". In more then 115 countries, boys, girls, teachers and families marched, drew, sung and danced so that their message could reach as many people as possible.

• In the framework of the latest Latin American Summits, the Spanish Coalition of the Global Campaign for Education presented **"Lights and Shadows: analysis of debt swap for education",** an analysis on how the debt swap for education is being carried out between Spain and several Latin American countries.

Every child needs a teacher. 2006 Education Action Week

Entreculturas thinks it is necessary that all governments both in the North and in the South recognize the vital role of teachers in society and that they invest in them. Teachers are a key tool in the formation of new social actors to promote political, economic and cultural changes.

The lack of training, low salaries, the high rate of students per teacher or diseases such as AIDS are the main factors that affect teachers in the most impoverished countries. An improvement of their training and salaries would motivate them and improve efficiency in their work.

-- A minimum of 15 million more teachers are estimated necessary to achieve universal primary education.

-- In many countries such as Chad, there are 69 students per teacher.

-- The earnings of a teacher in Nicaragua do not reach 3 dollars per day.

-- In Tanzania or Cape Verde, 60% of the teachers have only finished primary education.





• The- Coalition publishes a didactic guide on the situation of child soldiers.

• **The singer David Bisbal helps the** the Coalition to Stop the use of Child Soldiers. The singer from Malaga gives the rights of his song "Paper Soldiers" in which he denounces this situation.

- We join the Zero Poverty Campaign demonstrations throughout Spain in October to reach a State Agreement against poverty. Entreculturas leads the demand of the 2nd Millennium Goal "Universal Primary Education".
- As members of the Global Campaign for Education and the Zero Poverty Campaign we organize the seminar **"Education and Millennium Goals: current situation and evaluation"** with the University Comillas.
- Organization of the **"Zero Poverty" seminar,** together with the Centro Loyola of Santander.
- The **"No doubt, no debt"** campaign contributed to the debate on the new External Debt Law with a positioning document, a working session at Congress and a signature campaign at national level.
- At the **closing** of this campaign the need to "cancel in its totality the debt with Spain of the more impoverished countries" (Sub Saharan Africa, Heavily Indebted Poor Countries and Less Advanced Countries), was once again put forth.





The **Xavier Network** is a European platform for DNGO closely related to the Society of Jesus working for the promotion of justice and development of the world's less favoured populations. Reflection runs parallel to the support of joint activities in the South. Currently, it works for Africa's development with a joint programme in Mozambique and is also coordinated in answering emergency demands such as the South East Asian tsunami.

Advocacy in the business world

Business support for development

Business firms work with Entreculturas by allocating funds to projects in the South; supporting education for development projects; giving us their know-how and experience to improve our internal management; donating furniture and equipment or supporting our campaigns.

Awareness raising activities

We want to specially focus our activity on improving the perception and awareness of business firms on the impact their activities and investment decisions have on the less favoured. These awareness raising activities are directed to both inside the corporations (managers, stakeholders, employees) and outside (clients and suppliers).

Mutual learning: business firm-NGO

We try to influence, with dialogue, so that their policies might have a positive impact in eradicating poverty, protecting the environment and achieving a fairer society. Thus the importance of trying to establish long term goals.

- During 2006 more than 300 **business firms** have collaborated directly with Entreculturas.
- Launching of the programme **Business for education** targeted to the medium and small businesses and focused on the development Social Corporate Responsibility and the collaboration of this business area.
- We have collected 75.836 mobile telephones in the **"Donate your mobile Campaign"** jointly with the Red Cross. The 248.532 euros raised have been allocated to development projects. The number of mobiles collected has tripled over 2005. More than 1.000 business firms have installed plastic bag machines to collect and recycle the mobile telephones.
- More than 200 organizations use our Christmas Cards for Christmas Greetings.

There are 4.800 people participating in the Solidarity Euro campaign.

• Together with Entreculturas, Spanish business firms have engaged in installing information- technology systems in Latin American school classrooms.

• 31.000 people follow our **on-line courses for solidarity and volunteer** work from their firms

• Consolidation of the **Permanent Forum for business ethics and values.** Private and public university deans and academics share their thoughts on business ethics and values with high business and Administration officials. Two basic work groups, business and academicals, are set up. This Forum is jointly developed with the Cátedra de Ética Económica y Empresarial Javier Benjumea at the Comillas University. "With our work, we try to raise awareness in the business firms so they might assume their responsibility in the globalization of unfair economic structures. This responsibility is more evident in the countries of the South, where big corporations, through their business activities, can either promote or prevent sustainable development, eradication of poverty and the universal right of a dignified life. Therefore, when business firms work in our development projects, we talk about fair labour policies with their employees, fair ethical conduct with their clients, suppliers and stakeholders and environment policies". *Matías Oñate, Entreculturas Institutional Relations Department volunteer.*







More than 300 volunteers for social change

Entreculturas is engaged in voluntary work, not only because it allows achieving goals and objectives, but also because we see it as a path in which we learn together and we practice a different way of life. They work in the local and international volunteer programmes; at the head office or different delegations; living during two years in a country in the South, or giving a weekly time in our city...; only this personal change that takes place inside us can lead us to a true social change.

The value of commitment

* Volunteers in Spain. The work of Entreculturas is possible thanks to many people who dedicate their time and energy trying to be change agents in the North. Participating in awareness raising and advocacy campaigns, proposing education materials to schools, joining the Youth Solidarity networks, assisting our members and donors, implicating administrations and business firms are some of the activities carried out by volunteers to help change society.

* International Volunteer Programme, VOLPA. This programme invites those who wish to have an encounter with the South to be part of a development programme during one or two years. This programme is made up of three phases: a previous training, the experience in the South and a post volunteer period upon return. The fact of participating in the international volunteer praining means an important change in our way to look and position ourselves in the world. Upon return, volunteers are invited to continue their experience through their implication in their own environment, integrating what they have lived and learnt in the South.

* **Experience in the South.** For those people related to Entreculturas in Spain, this experience allows them to "put a face" to the South and get a first hand knowledge of Fe y Alegria's work during a few weeks.



No doubt, my volunteer experience in Tirúa has been a turning point in my life".

"I think it is a good idea to have a space in which to share opinions and experiences, especially with the volunteers we have in "Mi Rancho" who are constantly demanding it. I have always believed in the importance of the training there and the support and accompaniment here, and most of all the importance of the accompaniment upon return. VOLPA has sent us very valuable people, well trained by the previous course before the trip".

"I have been a couple of days in the interior of the country, near Tanzania where we are starting a cattle rearing project for the refugees returning to the country after the war. There, one can see what Burundi is really about. Few people speak French and it is difficult to make oneself understood. Being the only white person in the area does not help and children are very surprised when they see me, some of them even cry because when they are little and are naughty, their mothers tell them that the "whites" will come and eat them; just the opposite to Spain..."

Improving evaluation processes

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

• According to our aid policy and permanent contact with our local partners, our technical staff has visited projects in 17 countries.

• We evaluate, together with Fe y Alegría, the quality education at the centres of this Popular Education Movement.

• We travel to Bolivia to design, with Fundación ICO's support, a continuous **evaluation of the network Casas del Saber,** residences that help the school attendance of children in remote rural areas.

• We identify and adapt our **project management tool** to Fe y Alegria's needs in the Movement's regional offices.



Alert to new situations

• We have participated in the elaboration of the draft of the new syllabus **Education for Citizenship** so as to contribute to a global vision on human rights and the problems of the South. This is also our approach in our education materials.



For the third year running, Entreculturas consolidates its diversification income policy succeeding in balancing its private and public funds.

We want to point out that during 2006 funds from private sources have amounted to 54% of the total. Of these funds, revenue increase from members and donors has more than doubled in three years, from 4,5 million euros in 2003 to 9,8 million euros in 2006. This continuous support by our members and donors allows us a greater independence in our activities and to carry out a sustainable work in time and not only as an answer to emergencies.


Entreculturas allocates 92,8% of its funds to the two activities of its founding mission: cooperation for development in the South and awareness raising and advocacy in the North.

During 2006, for the first time total funds allocated to awareness raising and advocacy for social transformation have amounted to more than 1 million euros, which corresponds to 6% of our funds. Entreculturas has had a continuous commitment with this activity for the past seven years since it considers it key to reverse global injustice.

Since its foundation, Entreculturas has kept an efficient and at the same time austere management. During this period only 7,2% has been allocated to management expenses.

At the end of 2006, Entreculturas received non recurrent revenues which were not used during the year, generating a surplus of 913.413 euros. 650.000 euros of this surplus will be allocated to existing activities and the rest for the institution's reserves.

We offer a reader's guide to understand the different types of activities in the following pages.


1) **Projects, Programmes and Agreements.** Projects, Programmes and Agreements whose approved financial support has been managed by Entreculturas in 2006, are listed per country.

For those projects and programmes, that during 2006 have received support for the first time, information is given on total costs and financial donors.

In the projects supported during this year but initiated in previous years, only the quantity managed during 2005 is shown. In these latter cases, the total cost and activity description can be found in the correspondent report of the year it was initially approved.

We would like to draw attention to two programmes financed by the Spanish Agency for International Cooperation (AECI). On one hand the "Popular Quality Education for Social Inclusion and Education Equity 2004-2006" programme for Latin America Fe y Alegría National Offices. Therefore, the Programme amount allocation for each country is specified as well as the promoted activities. The amount allocated to the programme carried out in "Central America and the Caribbean" has been for this year, 2.402.510, 00 euros. The programmes developed in "South America" have received an amount of 2.403.190, 00 euros. On the other hand the amount allocated for the Basic Education Agreement for Latin America 2006-2010, also regional, has been 10.000.000,00 euros to be spread over four years. During 2006 we have focused in identitfying, describing and initiating three activites in Guatemala, Argentina and a regional Teacher Training programme.

2) Institutional Strengthening. This part includes funds allocated to strengthening the institutions we work with, so as to develop their capacities in areas such as management, organization, planning and financial sustainability, among others. During 2006 we have continued with the collaboration agreement between Entreculturas and Alboan for Fe y Alegria's Institutional Strengthening 2006-2008.
